STATION AREA NAME:

TASK ONE: PLACES

Where are historic places located along the University Avenue? What buildings, structures, cultural landmarks or public spaces should be preserved in the landscape of University Avenue and the surrounding neighborhoods?

TASK TWO: THEMES

Example: transportation, small business opportunity

TASK THREE: STRATEGIES

What strategies could be employed to preserve and or interpret the places and themes you listed above? How can we create a sense of place along the University that promotes its unique historic and cultural heritage?

Example: local historic designation, public art, streetscape design
